



- Financial Capital the infrastructure














Tonnes of oil equivalent / year in Europe

Planning Action

- Brownfield first policy 1976
- Greenfield zonings withdrawn
- Peripheral road schemes cancelled
- Out-of-town Retailing opposed
- Underground reopened
- Comprehensive Greenbelt
- No Transition

Impact

- 66%+ Housing brownfield
- 50% reduction in rate of urban sprawl
- £10bn additional private sector investment

3. The Obstacles to Spatial Efficiency



The Obstacles to Spatial Efficiency

If we are to deliver spatial efficiency we must:

- Not rely on the Market to deliver it
- Tackle the locked-in inefficiencies in urban structures
- Seek new governance arrangements

An unregulated Market-place

The Market is very imperfect because




- It speculates in land values
- Short term in its decisions
- Competition drives failure
- It is spatially blind to its impacts

... and results in inefficiency

(inequality and imbalance)

Locked-in Inefficiencies



80% of the future is already here!

- Energy waste
- Air quality problems
- Poor health & skill levels
- Eroded ecosystems


Example: Buildings are not cheap to run

Shakespeare Tower, Barbican

- Service charge £8,000 a year
- 11% of this (£880 per year per flat) is on window-cleaning alone








